Trade remedies are a means by which businesses can look to their governments to address the impacts of unfair or adverse trading practices (dumping, injurious subsidies or an unforeseen surge in imports). As governments continue to tackle the ongoing Covid-19 crisis, trade remedies are alive and well. In 2020, G20 Members initiated a total of 279 anti-dumping investigations, 54 countervailing duty investigations, and 10 safeguard investigations.

The most frequent initiators of trade remedy investigations in 2020 included India, the United States, Canada, Australia and the EU. In this webinar, members of the IPBA International Trade Committee will provide an overview of recent developments in trade remedies in key jurisdictions of interest to our Members.
