



### **Lucy Reed**

Lucy Reed is an independent arbitrator with Arbitration Chambers (New York), also serving as President of the Singapore International Arbitration Centre Court and President of the International Council for Commercial Arbitration (ICCA). Lucy retired in 2016 from Freshfields Bruckhaus Deringer, where she led the global international arbitration group from the New York, Hong Kong and Singapore offices, and then was Professor of Practice and Director of the Centre for International Law at NUS through 2019. In addition to practicing international commercial and investment treaty arbitration, she served as an arbitrator on the Eritrea-Ethiopia Claims Commission, co-director of the Claims Resolution Tribunal for Dormant Accounts in Switzerland (a Holocaust claims tribunal) and, while with the US State Department, the US Agent to the Iran-US Claims Tribunal. Lucy, a member of the US Council on Foreign Relations, is a former President of the American Society of International Law.
