Joongi (dʒun-gi) is a Professor at Yonsei Law School in Seoul, Korea. He serves as an ICC Court (alt) Member, ICC Institute of World Business Law Council Member, ITA Academic Council Member, and sits on the editorial boards of International Investment Law and Arbitration (Brill), Asian Journal of Comparative Law (Cambridge University Press), Dispute Resolution International (IBA) and Korean Arbitration Review.

He has acted as a presiding or sole arbitrator under the rules of the GGGI, HKIAC, ICC, ICSID, JCAA, KCAB, QICCA, SIAC, UNCITRAL, and VIAC.

In 2019, he was selected as International Arbitrator of the Year by KCAB International and the Korea Economic Daily and received the Top 10 Arbitrators in Asia Pacific Award by the Bali International Arbitration and Mediation Center.

His research focuses on international arbitration, international trade and investment, corporate governance and good governance, and his treatise International Arbitration In Korea (Oxford University Press 2017) received the 11th Simdang International Trade and Business Research Award.
