IPBA ASIA-PAC ARBITRATION DAY JOINTLY HOSTED WITH KLRCA

International arbitration evolves and develops with the challenges that new and complex disputes bring. Cross border transactions have become increasingly complex and the globalised world in which transactions are created, brings to a head various and differing bodies of law which lends added complexity to dispute resolution. This conference seeks to explore themes such as conflicts of law and privilege in differing legal systems and whether the application of international standards and the increased adoption of transnational laws is a good thing to achieve certainty and uniformity in these areas. Third Party funding, a hot button issue, will be explored in the context of managing escalating costs in arbitration. Sensibilities affecting multi-party and multi-contract dispute resolution, primarily in string sales contracts and sub-charter of vessels and the challenges in incorporation of arbitration clauses into bills of lading through charterparties and P&I Club undertakings, will be met with thought provoking discussion. These and other issues will be discussed comprehensively in this conference.
